On May 12, 2023 AAA4’s Governing Board unanimously adopted a recommendation from the Joint Program Evaluation Committee (JPEC) to revise the Performance Standards Policy. This change hereby discontinues the use of the term “Watch Status” and replaces it with the term “Collaborative Oversight Status” which is felt to be more descriptive of the Agency’s objective. Unlike “Watch Status,” the application of “Collaborative Oversight” requires that a notification be sent to the Funded Partner’s governing body to engage them in attempting to resolve matters before they rise to the level of a formal sanction.

A copy of the revised Policy is attached. It takes effect on the date this Bulletin is issued.
